
KNIT 1 DESIGNS

Materials:

- Yarn: 2 skeins "Santi II" by Illimani 137yd/125m;
Color: M4330
- Needle: US 13/8mm 16"/40cm in length.
- Cable needle.
- Darning needle for finishing.

Gauge:

Look at my note on Pg 2 for gauge with photos on Pg 3.

Glossary:

- K: knit
- P: purl
- C6F: Slip 3 stitches onto a cable needle and hold them at the front of the work. K the next 3sts from the left hand needle, then the 3 from the cable needle.
- C6B: The same as C6F, only hold the 3sts to the *back* of the work.
- rep: repeat
- sts: stitches



Santi II Cowl

A simple cowl worked from the top down, circularly in a Sand stitch pattern.

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Sand Stitch Pattern:

Multiple of 12sts

Pattern must be worked in the round.

Round 1: (RS) K.

Round 2 and all even numbered rounds: K.

Round 3: * C6F, K6, rep from * to end.

Round 5: As row 1.

Round 7: * K6, C6B, rep from * to end.

Round 9: As row 1.

Round 10: K.

Rep rows 3-10.

Begin Cowl:

Cast on 108sts. Join, careful not to twist.

Work Rounds 1 & 2 of Sand Stitch; then work 6 repeats of Rounds 3-10 of the Sand Stitch Pattern.

Work Rounds 3-7 once more.

Finishing Rounds:

Rounds 1-4: * K3, p1, repeat from * to end.

Bind off.

Weave in ends.

Finished measurements: 11.5" x 12.5" / 29.2cm x 31.75cm

Gauge:

When making things like this I'm not too concerned about gauge (unless it's super tight). I like to look at the pattern repeats of the stitches, count those repeats against my tape measure and go with that instead of the actual stitch count of the gauge.



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
